

**BYLAW NO. 19-09
TOWN OF FALHER**

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF FALHER IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADOPTING AN INTERMUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN.

WHEREAS the *Municipal Government Act*, being Chapter M-26 of the Statutes of Alberta 2000, and amendments thereto, allows two or more councils to pass a by-law to adopt an Intermunicipal Development Plan;

WHEREAS the Councils of the Town of Falher and the Municipal District of Smoky River No. 130 have recognized the need to cooperate in the planning of future land use and development along the shared common municipal boundary;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 631 of the *Municipal Government Act*, two or more municipalities must to jointly prepare an Intermunicipal Development Plan for an area of common interest or concern;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of **Town of Falher**, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled hereby enacts:

Title

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "IDP Bylaw".

Terms

2. The Intermunicipal Development Plan of Town of Falher and the Municipal District of Smoky River No. 130, attached to this bylaw as Schedule "A", is hereby adopted.
3. This Bylaw may be amended by Bylaw in accordance with the Municipal Government Act, as amended.

Enactment

4. This bylaw shall come into force and effect when it receives third and final reading and is duly signed.
