

**BYLAW NO. 20-03
TOWN OF FALHER**

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF FALHER, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 14-05.

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Falher, in the Province of Alberta has adopted Bylaw No. 14-05, being the Land Use Bylaw; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Falher, pursuant to the provisions of the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, deems it advisable to amend the said Bylaw.

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Falher, in the Province of Alberta, deems it necessary to amend the Town of Falher Land Use Bylaw to remove a minimum distance separation between a Cannabis Retail Sales and a liquor store;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Falher, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

Amendment

1. Replace Section 6.34.2 Cannabis Retail Sales with the following:

6.34.2 A Cannabis Retail Sales use shall not be located within 100 metres from:

- (a) a private or public school;
- (b) a provincial health care facility;
- (c) a park or playground;
- (d) a campground;
- (e) a recreational vehicle park;
- (f) an arena;
- (g) a public swimming pool; or
- (h) a cannabis retail store.

Severance

2. If any portion of this bylaw is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion shall be severed.

Enactment

3. That this bylaw shall take force and effect on the date of its final passage.
