

**BYLAW NO. 25-04
TOWN OF FALHER**

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF FALHER, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO APPOINT DESIGNATED OFFICERS.

WHEREAS PURSUANT TO PROVISIONS OF Section 210 of the Municipal Government Act, RSA Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto, the Council of the Town of Falher may pass a Bylaw for the establishment of one or more positions to carry out the powers, duties and functions of a designated officer under the Municipal Government Act or any other enactment or municipal bylaw;

AND WHEREAS Council of the Town of Falher deems it appropriate and desirable to appoint individuals as designated officers for assigned purposes.;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Falher, in the Province of Alberta duly assembled hereby enacts as follows:

1. TITLE

This Bylaw shall be cited as the "Designated Officer Bylaw"

2. DEFINITIONS

- a. **"Council"** means the Municipal Council of the municipal corporation of the Town of Falher.
- b. **"CAO"** means the Chief Administrative Officer, or their designate, for the Town of Falher.
- c. **"Municipality"** means the Town of Falher, a municipal corporation of the Province of Alberta and includes the area contained within the boundaries of the Municipality.
- d. **"Act"** means the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, C. M-26, any regulations thereunder, and any amendments or successor legislation thereto:

3. APPLICATION

- a. Those individuals appointed to perform the duties assigned to the following positions shall be declared as "Designate Officers" of the Town of Falher:
 - i. **Municipal Assessor**
 - ii. **Signing Authority (Accounting Clerk)**
- b. Those individuals appointed as Designated Officers of the Town of Falher may enforce any bylaw or enactment authorized by council of the Town of Falher, including but not limited to the ability to conduct inspections and issue enforcement orders.

4. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- a. The CAO may appoint an acting designated officer during an illness, scheduled absence or other incapacity of a designated officer.
- b. Bylaw No. 14-07 is hereby repealed
- c. This Bylaw shall be in effect on the final passing thereof.
